

**EXHIBIT "A"**  
**GEORGIA AQUATIC CENTER RULES AND REGULATIONS**

**County of Oconee, State of Georgia Rules:**

1. Unattended solo bathing is prohibited.
2. Children shall not use pool without an adult in attendance.
3. No glass articles allowed in or around the pool.
4. No food, drink or wrappers shall be permitted within ten (10) feet of the swimming pool or spa.
5. No running or rough play allowed.
6. No spitting, spouting of water or blowing nose in pool.
7. No cutoffs or exposed diapers allowed.
8. Only one bather at a time allowed on slide or diving board.
9. Sliding and diving areas must be clear of other patrons before diving or sliding is permitted.
10. No swimming allowed during heavy rain or when thunder or lightening can be seen or heard.

**Additional Georgia Aquatic Center rules:**

11. Pool hours shall be:

Monday – Saturday	8 a.m. to 8 p.m .
Sunday	1 p.m. to 8 p.m.

[Additional hours may be posted at the facility for lap swimming, masters swim program, high school swim program and summer swim leagues. Any changes to the above schedule will be clearly posted at the facility.]
12. Swimming at all times will be at your own risk.
13. If your child cannot swim, he/she must wear an approved lifesaving device such as a life jacket. Noodles, kick boards, etc. are not acceptable.
14. Public Health Standards require each person to shower before entering the pool. Please wash your feet before entering the pool from the play or picnic areas.
15. No pets on the property.
16. No child under 16 will be admitted without an adult.
17. Rubber diapers must be worn over swim diapers.
18. Do not throw loose change or other objects into the pool that might clog the pool filters.
19. Do not hang or sit on the pool ropes.
20. No smoking inside the pool facility.
21. Management or a lifeguard is authorized to clear the pool at any time by blowing a whistle. Those children repeatedly ignoring management or lifeguard's instructions or any pool rules will be asked to leave the swimming area.
22. Tubes, floats and balls are not permitted in the slide area of the pool nor during heavy swim loads, said determination to be at the discretion of management or lifeguards.
23. Members may bring a guest provided they pay \$5.00 per guest. Only adult members can sign in a guest. With the exception of out-of-town guests, the same guest may not be brought more than once every two weeks. The member is responsible for all of his/her guests, their actions, their conduct and adherence to all the rules.

24. There will be a 15-minute rest period every hour at the outdoor pool. It will begin on each hour and be for adults to swim and lifeguards to rest.
25. A non-member may accompany a member child as a baby-sitter. A completed permission slip provided by GAC must first be completed by the adult member. The babysitter must sign in. The pool management reserves the right to deny access to the pool to babysitters who are not supervising their charges.
26. The pool phone is intended for emergency calls only and for conducting pool business. It is not available for social calls to friends. A one-minute limit will be enforced for those using the phone.
27. Adults shall have priority in use of pool chairs.
28. Members must log-in each time they use the pool.
29. When a child reaches 21, he or she cannot be carried under parents' membership.
30. Help keep the GAC facilities clean and nice by using trash cans and remember to put your chairs away and take all your personal belongings home. Absolutely no CHEWING GUM will be allowed in the pool area. No BOBBY PINS or HAIR PINS or CURLERS of any sort will be allowed to be worn in the pool. No hard balls such as baseballs, softballs or golf balls nor metal or rigid plastic toys are permitted in the pool..
31. Admission to the pool may be refused to anyone with colds, coughs, inflamed eyes, skin eruptions, infections or malady of a contagious nature.
32. All injuries or accidents that occur on GAC grounds must be reported immediately to the manager or lifeguard.
33. Members should drive slowly and carefully in the parking area. Pedestrians and children on bicycles shall have the right-of-way at all times.
34. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is a matter of personal preference; however, members are encouraged to keep in mind the family atmosphere GAC espouses to maintain. Containers of alcoholic beverages should be kept out of sight. A person showing signs of intoxication may be denied use of the GAC facilities and is subject to suspension and/or expulsion. Consumption of alcoholic beverages by anyone under 21 is strictly prohibited.
35. No abusive or obscene language or acts will be tolerated.
36. Fires shall be permitted in the firepit only.
37. Property damage will be charged to the responsible member. GAC is not responsible for loss or damage to member's personal property.
38. When there are members waiting to play on the volleyball or tennis courts, the members playing must relinquish the court after one hour of play.
39. Skateboards, roller skates and bikes must be ridden only as a means of transportation to and from GAC property and never on tennis courts.
40. The possession or use of any weapon, including BB guns, on GAC property is strictly prohibited.
